

Zachary Thomas Wilkinson Memorial Scholarship

The Zachary Thomas Wilkinson Memorial Scholarship will be awarded to a 2011 graduate of Buckingham County High School. This scholarship is given to honor Zachary's life, dreams, and high hopes for the future.

The Zachary Thomas Wilkinson Memorial Scholarship will be awarded to a 2011 graduate of Buckingham County High School to aid the recipient in the pursuit of post high school education. The scholarship will be in the amount of \$1,000. Consideration will be given to applicants who, like Zachary, have the ambition and desire to further their studies in fields such as Engineering, Business Management, and Construction Management.

The deadline for applications is April 15, 2009. Applications may be obtained from the high school guidance office. Completed applications are to be returned to a Guidance Counselor at Buckingham County High School.

General Criteria for Consideration

- I. Each applicant must submit an essay that compares his/her future goals to those of Zachary Wilkinson. While it is not expected that the applicant will want to do everything Zachary wanted to do in life, the applicant should understand that Zachary was a dreamer and he had very high hopes for the future. Applicants are encouraged to visit Zachary's website at www.zackwilkinson.com to get a better understanding of what Zachary's dreams were for the future. Essay content should cover the above criteria and should include the following content:
 - A. Tell the trustees about yourself and how you have spent your high school years.
 - B. What makes you who you are today, and what do you want to see yourself doing in the future?
 - C. Zachary was a very special person. Tell the trustees what makes you special.
- II. Maintains a 2.5 or higher grade point average;
- III. Maintained high standards of conduct throughout high school;
- IV. Demonstrates leadership among peers;
- V. Indicates intent to continue in higher education after high school;
- VI. Provides two letters of reference from a teacher and someone in the community, other than a family member;
- VII. Provides a list of community and extracurricular activities that applicant has participated in over the past four or more years; and
- VIII. Provides a letter of acceptance from a college or university.
